### **What can you expect from your Corastone products?**

Corastone combines the beauty of natural stone with the functionality of a solid surface. This engineered Travertine is extremely resilient due to its blended mixture of calcium carbonate rocks, resins and proprietary additives. Its unique honed or semi-polished surface accentuates natural coloring and veining depending on various settings, angles and lighting. The same type of textural, color, finish, fills and surface variations we come to expect in natural Travertine are some of the unique nuances we find in Corastone. Even details like smaller holes and filled voids inherent to the Travertine family demonstrate the care with which Corastone is created.

**Corastone** currently offers 12-colors consistent with natural Travertine: the Classico family; Crema, Sienna, Carrara, and Livorno; the Viva family; Bianco, Light Travertine, Tuscany, Solara, and Venizio; and the Eleganza family; Imperio, Verona, and Cappuccino. Corastone can be utilized on bath counters, back-splashes, showers, soap dishes, and even fireplace mantels and hearths. Due to its unique processing, it can be fabricated and installed quickly and easily. Be sure to follow Corastone's installation and maintenance procedures.

### **Should I seal my Corastone surfaces?**

Corastone is a highly durable engineered Travertine. Sealing with high quality products every 2 - 4 years will keep it presentable and in good condition. Use a water-based sealer and ensure to test it in an inconspicuous place. Keep in mind, sealers are water-oil-stain-soil repellents; they don't water-oil-stain-soil proof surfaces.

### **How do I clean my Corastone surfaces?**

Corastone products are easy to clean. For general cleaning, use a clean and dry cotton cloth and neutral pH stone cleaner. All cleaners should be used as directed and tested for compatibility in an inconspicuous place. Proper maintenance is the key to keeping your Corastone surfaces presentable and in good condition for years to come.

### **How often do I need to clean my Corastone surfaces?**

Like many other natural and manufactured materials, weekly cleaning is recommended. However, more frequent cleaning may be required dependent on frequency of use, various personal toiletries and cleaners, and minerals in water. Immediate cleaning is best for any spills. Clean and wipe-up spills with clean dry cotton cloth and neutral pH stone-cleaner as soon as possible and dry thoroughly with a clean cloth.

## Recommended Care & Cleaning

Simple routine care will help to keep your Corastone surface clean and looking as good as new. Water conditions in various areas will determine any extra cleaning attention needed for your bathroom. Mild abrasive cleaners may be used occasionally if water deposits become visible. Corastone will change color slightly when wet, just like natural stone, but it should return to its original color when dry.

### **What types of cleaners are best for every day types of wear?**

Lysol  
409 All Purpose  
Fantastik with Anti-bacterial additive  
Gel Gloss (for semi-polished surfaces only)  
Miracle Sealants water-based sealers and enhancer-sealers

Avoid acidic-based cleaners, as they will etch Corastone just like natural travertine. When using chemicals test them in an inconspicuous place and follow directions. Do not let cleaners dwell too long on the surfaces.

### **For oily stains:**

Always follow directions on the bottle, and first test in an inconspicuous location. Use a neutral pH, non-acidic degreaser. Always follow directions on the bottle. Spray stain degreaser, blot and wipe clean with a damp towel. Re-clean area with neutral pH stone soap and a clean dry towel.

### **For soap residue:**

Always follow directions on the bottle, and first test in an inconspicuous location. Use a neutral pH, non-acidic degreaser. Always follow directions on the bottle. Spray stain degreaser, blot and wipe clean with a damp towel. Re-clean area with neutral pH stone soap and a clean dry towel.

### **For water spots:**

Always follow directions on the bottle, and first test in an inconspicuous location. Mild liquid abrasive cleaners like Soft Scrub will help to diminish water spots. Dampen a small section of a cotton towel with mild abrasive, and dab onto water spots. Lightly agitate the stain in a circular motion with a white scrub pad. Clean area with neutral pH stone soap and a clean dry cotton cloth. Corastone will darken when exposed to water just like natural stone and will return to its original color once it dries.

### **For light scratches that may scuff the surface:**

Like natural stone, Corastone has numerous variations and nuances, and every slab is unique. In some situations, surface blemishes like minor marks and scratches may be visible when inspected very closely. If the marks or scratches are not corrected through sealing, then diminish with a dry Scotch Brite green pad or wet/dry 400 grit sandpaper and orbital sander for honed Corastone products. Apply only light pressure and check often. Polishing compounds are best for semi-polished products.
